- ***Bored of packing a packed lunch and of finding things to fill it? Let us help you. Let your child enjoy the selection of fresh food we have to offer at a very low rate.***
- ***Have a fussy eater? Let them try some hot cooked meals alongside their friend. It's a known fact that children copy others especially their peers.***
- ***Had a long day at work? We're looking to take the pressure way from you. If you know your child has had a home cooked hot meal during the day this should make tea time a little easier.***

Starting after half term (w/c 20.2.17) at Sunshine, we are introducing home cooked hot lunches. We hope that for parents this addition will remove some stress from the busy start of the day when trying to get the family ready and out of the house.



This will of course be optional and we will be charging an introductory rate of £1.00 per day. To ensure we cater for the correct amount of children we are asking that this is booked with us in advance. However subject to availability we will be able to take payment on the day as long as this is before 9.15.

Meals will be home cooked at the Dolphin and delivered to Sunshine piping hot in a specialised container to ensure it is kept at the correct temperature for serving. All produce is fresh and locally sourced, using Reynolds butchers for all meat.

Our menu has been produced to ensure the children receive a balanced healthy meal each day providing them with everything a growing body needs. We have attached our trial menu which is subject to change after Easter. A copy will also be included to your child's all about me book and on the wall in the entrance porch.

Allergies have already been considered but should you feel the menu contains anything that could affect your child then please speak to Kyah. Booking is nice and easy, please just speak to a member of the team.



Extended opening hours

Feedback from parents has been positive to our extended opening. So positive in fact that we are looking to bring this forward from September to after Easter but before we do we wanted to ask for your further thoughts.

It was clear that opening our doors earlier in the morning and staying open later in the evening would allow parents to do the school run to fit around us, either before or after and also give working parents additional time, flexibility and hopefully less stress.

After consulting with our landlord, we would be able to use the hall from 8am and until 5pm except on a Thursday when another user would restrict our opening until 3pm.

We would still look to offer the funded session between 9-3 but offering a chargeable breakfast club between 8-9am and for after 3pm a chargeable after school club.

These chargeable extra sessions are where we would like your input and help.

Breakfast club

Arrive anytime between 8-8.30 to have breakfast included. Breakfast will be self-serve buffet style offering the children a choice of cereals and selection of pastries. This is aimed to further enable the children's independence and give them vital life skills all in a safe and enjoyable environment.
